Thank you for your using QuickMask.

QuickMask is a very simple application that enables the user to import a graphic file with an alpha layer and generate a mask file compressed in JPEG. It's an ideal application for IDE users who want to save time by quickly generating mask images instead of applying specific effects and choosing the right graphic format. One can certainly use Apple's Preview to generate the same kind of mask files by manipulating Brightness, Contrast and Exposure under the Adjust Color window.

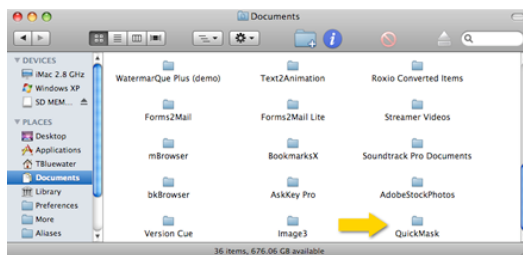
'Freeware' doesn't mean you have the right to distribute this product. It should not imply that you have developed it in the first place.

MacHouse is the sole distributor of QuickMask. No party is allowed to distribute or redistribute software without permission.

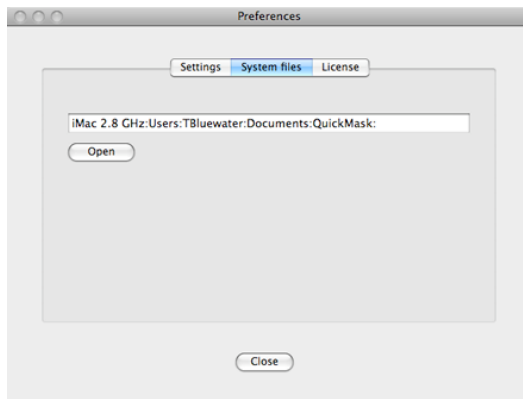
## 3. Installing QuickMask

You can give it its own folder if you like, or just drag and drop a copy of QuickMask anywhere even inside a USB drive. And you are all set.



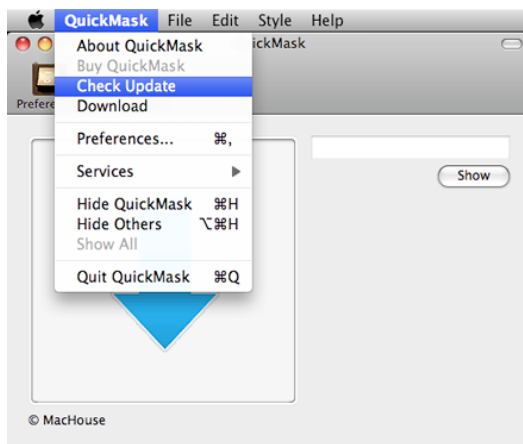
## 4. Uninstalling QuickMask

When launched for the first time, QuickMask creates a folder containing one or more files inside the **Document** folder, which you need to trash on top of the application file itself. You can find this folder easily by opening **Preferences**. Switch tabs to **System files** and then click on the **Open** button.



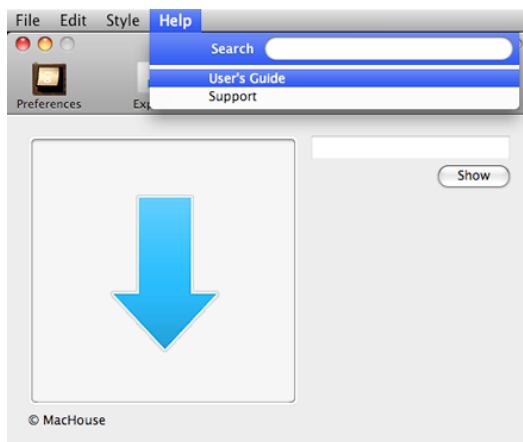
## 5. Updating QuickMask
